

Digital Upload Specifications and Guidelines

- Position the camera to take an image as squared and “tight” as possible to the artwork.
- Make sure the photo is well lit with no glares or shadows on the artwork. Providing a clear representation of the artwork is very important as judging will be based on the photos.
- Use a neutral or non-distracting background.
- Images may not be digitally altered apart from color correction if necessary.
- Please limit your file size to 2.5 MB per file if possible.
- Please name your file with the following convention:
ArtistName_Grade_Title_Medium. Example: JaneDoe_9_Seascape_Painting

Accepted Mediums (Label your file with one of the following)

Painting	Pencil/Charcoal	Color Pencil/Marker
Mixed Media 3-D (MM3D)	Mixed Media 2-D (MM2D)	Fiber Art
Photography	Digital Art	Printmaking
Ceramics	Drawing-Other (<i>Pastel/Chalk/Ink</i>)	

- Up to 2 photos may be uploaded per piece. A second photo may be useful for a close up to show detail of a piece or to show the photo from a different angle or side for a 3 dimensional piece.
